

Smeagol ACADEMIC LICENCE

Version 1.1

1. Preamble and Definition

The SMEAGOL program has been devised for its general use in research within the academic community. Some conditions have been defined for the use, distribution and modification of SMEAGOL. These are considered fair by the authors and are common practice within the academic community.

The SMEAGOL “Authors” are:

The Authors are also the “Copyright Holder” of the SMEAGOL package, and the valid “Distributors”.

The “Licensee” is the person (not the institution) to whom the SMEAGOL package is distributed (under the terms of this Licence) by the Distributors: they are bound by this agreement.

The “SMEAGOL package” is the suite of software, including the SMEAGOL code itself, but also all other software, documentation, scripts, and ancillary support material distributed as a single entity (but not the SIESTA code). This Licence covers the entirety of the SMEAGOL Package.

This Licence covers the use and the distribution of the SMEAGOL package only. The SMEAGOL package itself depends for its core functions from the Density Functional Theory code SIESTA, which is not distributed together with SMEAGOL. It is responsibility of the Licensee to download the code SIESTA from the relevant web-site and to satisfy all necessary licence conditions relating to use of SIESTA.

2. No Warranty

There is no warranty for any part of the SMEAGOL package. The SMEAGOL package is provided without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. In no event shall the Distributors be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, or consequential damages (including, but not limited to, procurement of substitute goods or services; loss of use, data, or profits; or business interruption) however caused and on any theory of liability, whether in contract, strict liability, or tort (including negligence or otherwise) arising in any way out for the use of this software, even if advised of the possibility of such damage. The entire

risk as to the quality or performance of the program, or any action the Licensee may take based on the output of any part of the SMEAGOL package, is with the Licensee.

The SMEAGOL authors are not responsible by any mean of the missuse, damage, or illegal download of the associated code SIESTA.

3. Grant and Limitations

The Licensee is hereby provided with a non-exclusive, royalty-free right to use any part of the SMEAGOL Package, and to display, publish, perform, or otherwise use results obtained by use of the SMEAGOL Package in any form.

The use of the SMEAGOL Package under the present Licence is restricted solely to academic institutions (including universities and non-military public research laboratories) and for academic purposes, i.e. leading to open publication of results, with neither withholding of information nor intentional delay in publication. Notwithstanding these general definitions, the Authors reserve the exclusive right to determine what purposes and institutions are eligible for using the SMEAGOL Package under this Licence, and to withhold the right to use the SMEAGOL Package.

Further, the Authors reserve the right to revoke the Licence (by 30 days notice in writing) where they have reasonable evidence to believe that their original decision to grant the licence was incorrect, or that the institution and/or use being made of the SMEAGOL Package has changed and no longer qualifies for this Licence.

The Licensee is subject to the following restrictions:

1. The first publication arising from use of SMEAGOL partially or as a whole must be considered as “in collaboration” with one of the SMEAGOL teams. The Licensee is required to identify one of the SMEAGOL teams as collaborator before engaging in a SMEAGOL project.
2. In any subsequent paper (after the first) or other academic publication containing results wholly or partially derived from the use of the SMEAGOL package, the following papers must be cited.

3. Other papers relevant to the SMEAGOL package and method should be cited as best scientific practice dictates.

Licensees are recommended to send reference to the Authors of any publication containing results wholly or partially derived from the results of use of the SMEAGOL package.

The above-mentioned right to use the code is extensive to the member of the research group of the Licensee as long as the use is in collaboration with the Licensee leading to co-authored publication(s).

4. Support

The present License does not imply support services of any kind to the Licensee by the Distributors, including, but not limited to, installation, compilation and use of the software in the package.

5. Modification

Licensees are permitted to modify SMEAGOL for their own private use; in any paper containing results wholly or partially derived from the use of a modified version of SMEAGOL, the authors are required to state that a privately modified version of SMEAGOL is used, and satisfy the conditions of use stated in the paragraph above.

The Authors encourage Licensees to submit their modifications of the SMEAGOL package to them, so that the SMEAGOL package does not fork, and furthermore so that the package can be improved for all users. Licensees can thereby benefit from the ulterior developments of SMEAGOL.

To this end, the Authors wish to encourage Licensees to make any modifications to the SMEAGOL package in as modular fashion as possible: for example, interacting via files, or via well-defined interface calls. This permits maintenance of these modifications as a separate entity in many cases, and may allow their separation from SMEAGOL and distribution as a separate piece of software: in that case, such software is not subject to this License, and the authors of the separate software are free to choose any licensing terms they desire.

However, if a given modification must be incorporated directly into the SMEAGOL package, the author(s) of any such modifications must provide a perpetual royalty-free, irrevocable license to the Authors, and the Copyright-Holder, to further modify their modifications ("The Contributed Code") as may prove necessary for the future development of SMEAGOL, and to distribute the "Contributed Code" (in its original or any later modified form) as part of the SMEAGOL package.

The Authors, in the interests of maintaining the efficiency of the SMEAGOL package and the modularity of its code base, actively encourage all those considering modifications to the SMEAGOL package to discuss their planned modifications with the Authors beforehand.

6. Redistribution

The Authors reserve the exclusive right to distribute the SMEAGOL package. Licensees have no right to distribute the SMEAGOL package, a modified or alternative version thereof, or any other program making direct use of parts of the SMEAGOL package, without the prior written consent of the Distributors.

7. All Other Rights

All other rights not explicitly mentioned in this document are reserved. In particular, the Authors reserve all rights to resolve any and all conflicts arising in the development and distribution policies of the SMEAGOL package.

All Licensees, receiving the SMEAGOL Package for any purpose,

accept all the conditions in this Licence by signing below.

This Licence takes effect when a copy of this document (previously signed and dated by the prospective Licensee and sent to the Authors) is returned counter-signed by one of the Authors to the Licensee, and not before.

Without a valid License, a prospective Licensee does not have the right to use or modify the SMEAGOL package.

Everyone is permitted to copy and distribute verbatim copies of this License document, but changing it is not permitted.
